

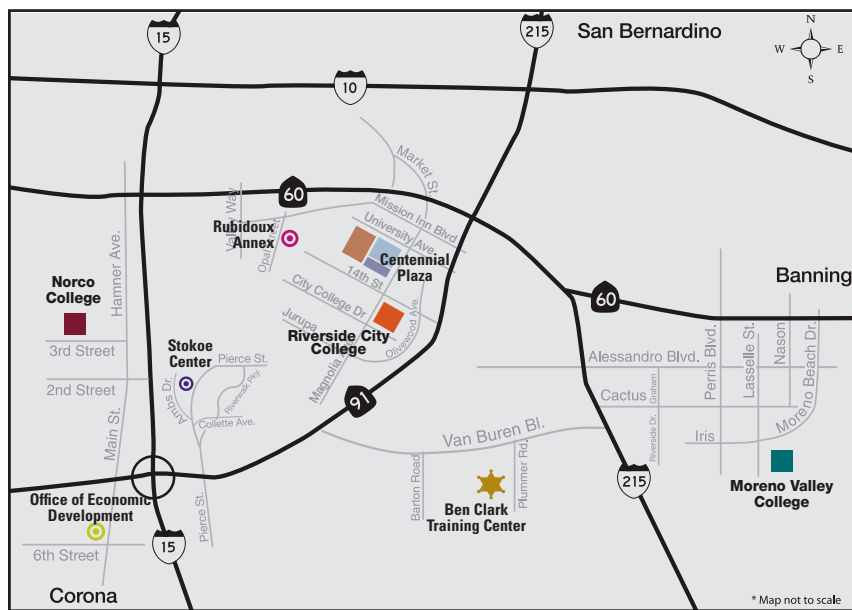

## District Overview

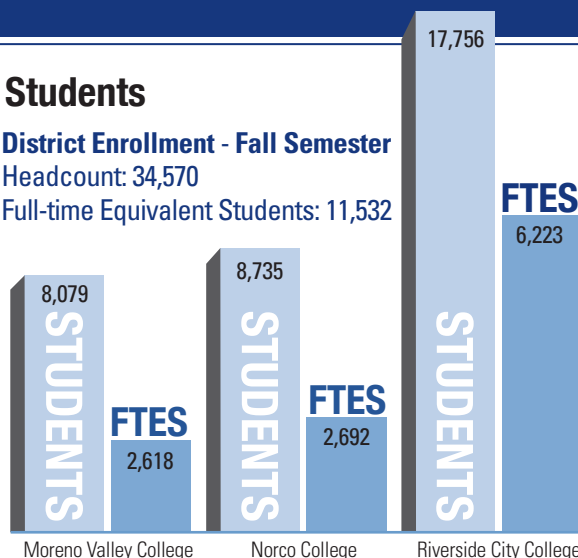

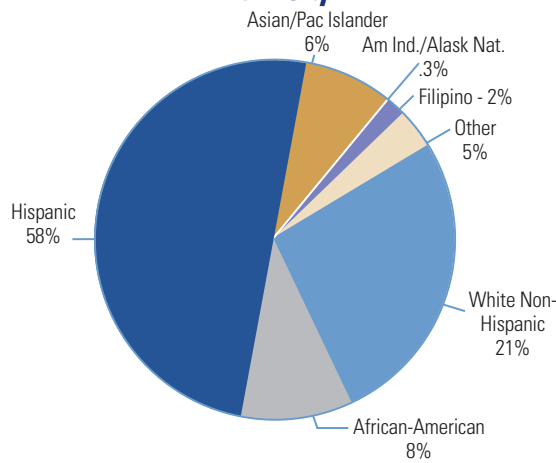
- RCCD serves six K-12 unified school districts

 Full-time Equivalent Students: 11,532

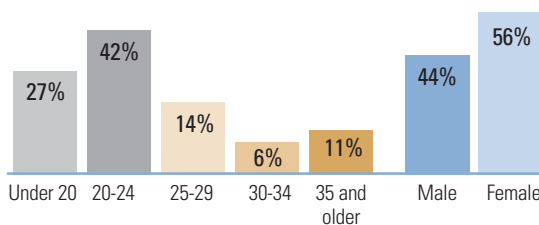


## Ethnicity



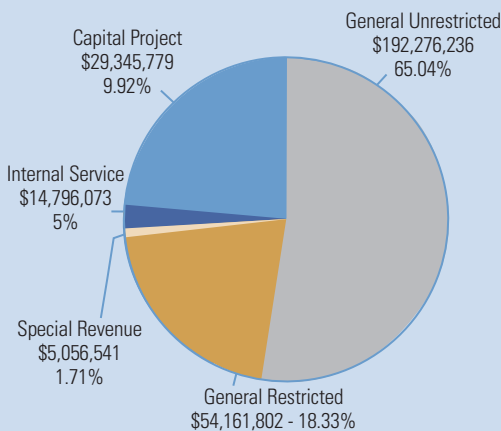
## Age

## Gender



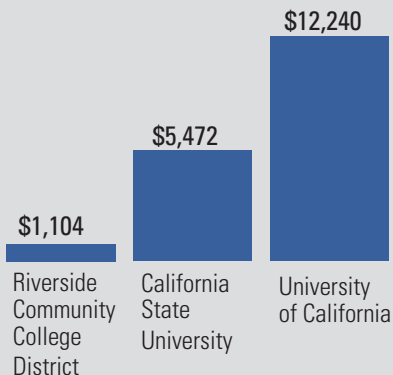
## 2015-2016 Proposed Budget

## RCCD Students - Financial Aid

\$78,230,552 in financial aid dollars was awarded to 29,991 students. 56.2% of RCCD students receive the Board of Governors (BOG) waiver.

## Economic Impact

The RCCD is a major engine of economic growth in the Inland Empire.

- RCCD generated approximately \$5.6 billion in economic impact on the state of California.
- \$842.7 million in added income by activity associated with the district's three colleges in 2013-14.
- Thousands of former students are employed in the RCCD Service Area.
- The accumulated contribution of RCCD alumni currently employed in the region was \$663.7 million (during 2013-14).
