Nick Goldware is a well-known business leader and executive vice president of HUB International Insurance Services Incorporated.

Goldware attended RCC in the mid-60's and played football under respected coach Bob Dohr before becoming UC Riverside's starting quarterback and being named among the best small college quarterbacks in the nation.

In his professional life, Goldware has spent 40 years in the insurance industry, first as an employee, then as a partner in his father's firm, and later as the owner of the largest independent insurance agency in the Inland Empire.
