AP 2010 ACADEMIC CALENDAR

Per the Agreement between the District and the RCCD Chapter of the Faculty association CCA/CTANEA, the academic calendar is negotiated in accordance with the Education Code and Title 5.

The academic year shall consist of 175 days of instruction.

Statutory holidays are observed on the dates noted or on alternate dates in accordance with the Education Code, and include:

New Year's Day (January 1)
Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (Third Monday in January)
Lincoln Day and Washington Day – These holidays are generally combined and scheduled using State Chancellor's Office guidelines
Cesar Chavez Day (March 31)
Memorial Day (Last Monday in May)
Independence Day (July 4)
Labor Day (First Monday in September)
Veterans Day (November 11)
Thanksgiving Day (Fourth Thursday in November)
Christmas Day (December 25)

The Board of Trustees may declare other days to be holidays and close the colleges and offices when good reason exists.
