#### II. FTES Update

Steven Butler updated everyone that RCCD has achieved 97.5% of its Spring 2025 FTES target, with 12,302.03 FTES out of the 12,611 target. RCC achieved 97.7% of their targets, Norco achieved 97.8% of their targets, and MVC achieved 96.9% of their targets so far. Compared to the same period last year, Spring 2025 enrollment is approximately 1.7% higher. The 2024-25 annual FTES goal is at 102.3% of target. RCCD has achieved 72% of its noncredit/Adult Ed FTES target.

# IV. New Accounting Method Simulations

Steven Butler updated the committee that Institutional Research has run various simulations to test the new accounting method. The new standard accounting method is based on units not contact hours. For example, converting lab hours into units and rounding them down may result in a loss. If we do not make

changes to the CORs, we may loss 4% in one semester. English and Math classes are particularly affected by this new accounting method, and a recommendation was made to explain this issue to all English and Math faculty and explore possible solutions.
