REPORTS

- **a.** Chancellor was impressed with the final Centennial Strategic Plan which is the first strategic plan for this District as a multi-college district. All of our strategic planning documents, now in place, are recognized as being very dynamic and succinct. The Committee will continue to review and refine the plan as needed.
- Two of the Academic Senates have proposed revisions to the structure and operational guidelines of the District Strategic Planning Committee. The Chancellor's Office is continuing its review and consideration of the proposed changes. In general, operational guidelines and related structural issues of the DSPC will be reviewed at every September meeting for updating and revisions, as needed.
- Aaron Brown is spearheading the Budget Allocation Model, particularly enrollments and FTEs.

- a. Presentation of Norco College Facilities Master Plan Dr. Parnell presented the draft of Norco College's Facilities Master Plan. It will be forwarded for final approval to the June 2013 board.

The second entity listed will provide support. Where the action or goal was determined to require equal leadership and responsibility, the term "equally shared" was noted.

The DSPC considered Student Access and Student Learning and Success strategic themes first, discussed them, and then voted on the final listing of locus of responsibility and leadership for these two themes.

The DSPC then repeated this procedure for Resource Steward/Community Collaboration and Partnership, followed by Creativity and Innovation/System Effectiveness.
