1. Moreno Valley

a. Continuing to implement the sunset policy.

a. Approved the RCCD GE Area 7 Lifelong Learning and discussed the descriptor. Also discussed the CCN templates for Phase 2 and the Phase 3 pre-convening surveys.



#### 3. Riverside

- a. RCC curriculum committee had some very specific requests regarding the Lifelong Learning Descriptor. Kelly Douglass would like to bring this item back to Standards to provide some language regarding encouraging equity mindedness that aligns with the ASCCC language.
- b. The committee also discussed the need for a wide-scale, District-wide alert to students regarding the changes to CCN courses. We know the systems and catalog are changing, but where is the information on the website?
  - i. Casandra Greene Presented at the RIV Academic Senate on the CCN changes from an operational stand point. They also had questions about the marketing campaign.
  - ii. Eric Bishop Working with VC Goldware to create a campaign that can be used across all three colleges given the impact to students, counselors, faculty, etc.
  - iii. Kelly Douglass Should make sure to communicate that this isn't a complicated change, it's just a name change. Should investigate if there is a way in WebAdvisor and EduNav to display that ENG-1A is now ENGL-C1000. Also concerned about enrollment drop-off due to confusion.

- 1. General Work Experience Casandra Greene/Kelly Douglass
  - a. Casandra Greene Casandra has been working with faculty on the discipline specific courses, however, who owns the General Work Experience course? Who is the faculty member who brings it into compliance?
    - i. Nick Sinigaglia Aren't we getting rid of the general course?
    - ii. Casandra Greene Students can still take a general, non-discipline specific course, but if the course is offered, we need to know who is responsible for it.
  - b. Brian Johnson Maybe a CTE dean or faculty within CTE who works with the dean.
  - c. Casandra Greene will discuss with the CTE dean and this topic will be placed on the May 6 DCC agenda.

# 2. Open Forum

- a. Kelly Douglass Is anyone aware of any update regarding the status of the chaptering of the Title 5 language? Has anyone heard if the State Chancellor's Office is going to allow updates to be made on a rolling basis?
  - i. That have been no updates.
- b. Kelly Douglass Do we have any updates on the simulations being run for the updated attendance accounting method?



- i. Eric Bishop We are still running additional simulations and working to get additional interpretations from other districts. We have discussed this with the VPAAs and the District Enrollment Management Committee in an effort to find the best solution.
- ii. Kelly Douglass We cannot increase the units on ENG-1A to 4.5 units. This would be a non-starter. Hopeful we will not have to make any change based how generous the rest of the funding method is. We have had the labs since the 80s and they are beneficial for students.
- iii. Kelly Douglass Requested a list of courses that do not calculate perfectly to an increment of units.
- iv. Kelly Douglass Additionally, concerned about when this topic will be brought forward to faculty for discussion.
  - 1. Eric Bishop This is one of the reasons we brought it to the enrollment committee as there are faculty present on the committee.
