#### **Discussion Items and Public Comment**

- 1. DAS has asked if district workforce and economic development committee could report/give update to DCC Brian Johnson
  - a. Kimberly Bell sent an e-mail to Brian Johnson regarding the not-for-credit courses that the District is looking to implement and wants a mechanism in place to see when proposals may overlap with curriculum. The Senate Presidents suggested regular updates to ensure there are checks and balances.
  - b. Kelly Douglass The District has offered contract not-for-credit courses in the past. Concern is that it is expanding, and the concern among faculty in CTE in particular is that some things may overlap with noncredit that we currently offer or could potentially offer. Having reports at DCC is a good start, but that is not a process. Simply coming to report once should not give the impression that there is approval from the curriculum committees. If we have an actual process, it should be more than the three chairs. It should be integrated into our local process where we get a list of proposed future courses before they sign the contract. This would then be shared to the committees and that is how the colleges learn where things intersect.
  - c. Nick Sinigaglia There's a whole section in the faculty contract related to not-for-credit courses. It has to be run through the potentially affected departments to check for duplication, so the District's action was a clear contract violation. The process must build off of the contract.
  - d. Kelly Douglass We need a short, single-page outline that shows what exactly the timeline is, what we share with faculty, what faculty need to review and their timeline for performing that review. It cannot be a single report and must be a conversation that facilitates the process in the contract. A proposal can be developed in the spring.
- 2. Equity-Related Sub-standards from ACCJC Nick Sinigaglia
  - a. One of the ACCJC sub-standards for accreditation has to do with equity. Is there a formal process to address equity gaps in curriculum proposals? This already happens at the program review level.
  - b. Kelly Douglass There is a COR Review Tool on the District and RCC curriculum pages that has recommendations for curriculum review as well as performing a review in an equity minded way. This was approved by DCC several years ago. At RCC, any time faculty put forward a COR with equity minded outcomes, there is robust conversation and careful review of the content to ensure there is content that supports the outcome. Additionally, the State Chancellor's Office has a spreadsheet of equity goals and how to embed them in the COR.
  - c. Nick Sinigaglia Title 5 revisions are being proposed that will require that the COR include content that ensures equity as well as a documented procedure.
- 3. Open Forum
  - a. Brian Johnson Presented the Independent Study AP to District Senate. Stated Curriculum has done as much work as is possible on the AP, but their action is needed.



Recommended that Senate have a discussion on whether the AP is appropriate at all.

- b. Bryan Medina In order to meet the December Board, a special DCC after the next college meeting will need to be scheduled.
