Rationale:

Increasing the number of courses offered at MVC will increase the overall enrollment at the College. Additionally, there is a lot of wonderful opportunities near MVC that allow for unique ways to study ecology not available to the other schools, specifically referring to the Jaeger Desert Institute, which allows for students to learn about the natural world on campus, and the Lake Perris Reservoir, which is about 15 minutes from campus and will allow for opportunities for students to develop an appreciation for local conservation and potential employment opportunities. Finally, the success of the Environmental Science course (BIOL 19) demonstrates student demand for new biological courses that focus on natural systems and our role in them.

ADJ 12L [Introduction to Criminalistics Laboratory](#)

Rationale: ADJ-12 Introduction to Criminalistics historically was allotted 12 hours of lab within the 54 hours lecture, resulting in a 3 credit course for ADJ-12. Criminalistics and Forensic Science is a laboratory heavy discipline and the course should reflect this; 12 hours total is not nearly enough time to meet the basic best practices standards for a college-level course in forensic sciences, and students must be engaged in opportunities to build, develop, and demonstrate basic and intermediate laboratory skills specific to criminalistics and forensic science, for both academic knowledge and awareness as well as industry-specific competitiveness in hiring and employability. Criminalistics is a specific knowledge and skill-heavy specialization within STEM that requires an equal, if not more, amount of time/hours/exposure/experience/guidance to laboratory courses that are more common, such as those provided in Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Anthropology. The creation of ADJ-12L, the 1 credit laboratory course, reflects this commitment to student academic knowledge and expansion along with industry-specific skillbuilding and best practices guidance, placing RCC students within this discipline and within the course with cutting-edge and unique experience and exposure, particularly as there are no currently known classes at any other community college within the state that offer the criminalistics laboratory course; this also appears to be reflected in its notable absence from the CSU system as well.

ADJ 28L [Crime Scene Investigation Laboratory](#)

Rationale: ADJ-28 Crime Scene Investigation, a new offering, was initially created with the intention of matching existing lab hour courses (ADJ-12, ADJ-31) which had 12 lab hours for 54 hours of lecture. However, Crime Scene Investigation is a skills-heavy specialization requiring significant technical knowledge and demonstrable ability and educational offerings should reflect this. 12 hours total is not nearly enough time to meet the basic best practices standards for a college-level course in crime scene investigation and its multiple knowledge domains, and students must be engaged in opportunities to build, develop, and demonstrate basic and intermediate level skill and technical ability specific to crime scene investigation industry needs and best practices.

ADJ 32 [Criminal Case Law](#)

Rationale: Criminal case law is the foundation of all real world and industry-specific procedure; the absence of criminal case law courses, with an intense focus upon legal knowledge and analysis, is glaring within the review of current California criminal justice education systems, especially within an undergraduate level. This course will allow students to obtain directed and repeated intensive education, exposure, and knowledge analysis within case law pertinent to criminal law, with a specific focus upon the 4th, 5th, and 6th Amendments.

ELE 33 [Network Troubleshooting and Methodology in Biomedical Equipment](#)

Rationale: For students and new healthcare professionals, an introduction to medical equipment is an essential part of their education and training. It lays the foundation for more advanced learning and specialization in specific areas of medicine and medical technology.

KIN A08B [Pickleball, Intermediate](#)

The intention for the Modern Policing Degree and the future of law enforcement is to be inclusive of the diverse perspectives of stakeholders, the 2020 Call to Action against systemic racism, the California Community Colleges system goals for equity as laid forth in the California Community Colleges Vision 2030, and the requirements of AB 89. This proposed degree for Modern Policing is the culmination of work from numerous stakeholders throughout our system to provide a prescriptive framework of courses to create a degree that leads to employment in the field. In addition to the content identified in AB 89 and AB 1122, courses and topics incorporated into the Modern Policing Degree curriculum contribute to an officer's critical thinking skills and emotional intelligence. Graduates with this degree will exhibit cultural competence, which is the ability to honor and respect the beliefs, language, interpersonal styles, behaviors, and lifestyles of those receiving and providing services. The Modern Policing degree is not intended to replace existing ADTs in Administration of Justice or local associate's degrees in administration of justice. It is intended to be a third option that includes elements of both types of degrees to satisfy the state's requirements in AB 89.
