Discussion Items and Public Comment

- 1. ESL-C1000 Process Kelly Douglass
 - a. At the last meeting, the committee discussed that ESL faculty are seeking to create an ESL-C1000 course that has the same articulation as ENGL-C1000. How do we communicate to students that they cannot earn credit for ENGL-C1000 and ESL-C1000?
 - b. Is the correct order of operations the following?
 - i. Launch the ESL course without the statement in the description and submit it for articulation. When it is articulated the same way as ENG-C1000, modify ESL-



- C1000, ENGL-C1000, and ENGL-C1000H to state that students can only receive credit for one. Then, perform the course/program changes necessary to add the ESL course where applicable.
- ii. Nick Franco Would want to ensure the course is not offered until it has been fully articulated.
- iii. Bryan Medina As long as we don't build the course in Colleague, it won't be possible to schedule it.
- iv. Kelly Douglass So the statement should not appear until the ESL course is fully articulated.
- c. Kelly Douglass Should RIV launch the course first, and then NOR and MOV include it later?
 - i. Nick Franco The proposal should be launch with all three colleges at the same time. Sometimes when a course is adopted by a college later, we've received different articulation decisions. Submitting for all three colleges at once will help with submissions for articulation.
- d. Brian Johnson The addition of the sentence that students can only take one of the courses might be something that can be done clerically.
- 2. Curriqunet Permissions for Part-Time Faculty Bryan Medina
 - a. Steven Schmidt Only full-time faculty should have origination permissions in Curriqunet. Part-time faculty can be added to proposals as co-contributors. What should we do when there are no full-time faculty in a discipline?
 - i. Brian Johnson The Department Chair could be the originator.
 - ii. Kelly Douglass The Department Chair may not technically have the discipline permissions in Curriqunet or the subject matter expertise. We might need to address this on a case-by-case basis.
 - iii. Brian Johnson We should also question why we would have a discipline with no full-time faculty. Adjunct may only be in the district for a single term.

3. Open Forum

- a. Kelly Douglass We have heard that the efforts from VPAA Lynn Wright and others to work with the State Chancellor's Office to allow 18 hour labs to continue to be funded was denied. Classes with hours that do not add up to an exact increment of unit credit will not be funded. However, they did give us an additional year to adopt the new attendance accounting method, which is Fall 2027, which means any changes to courses must be launched in Fall 2026, which is the same time as Phase 2B and Phase 3 of CCN. Faculty will need to begin thinking about their courses. What is the communication plan? Are we waiting on anything further form the District?
 - i. Lijuan Zhai The memo released by the State Chancellor's Office does allow for an additional year. The memo has two suggestions regarding changing courses with unfunded labs. The District Institutional Effectiveness office is looking at the computation for FTES and will continue to meet with the VPAAs.
 - ii. Kelly Douglass There are changes beyond FTES. If ENG-1A is changed from a 4.33 unit course to a 4 unit course, this has implications on faculty load and room scheduling. We also need to ensure we are preserving pedagogy.
 - iii. Kelly Douglass Generally, when new courses come forward with an unfunded lab, we should draw it to the attention of the originator.
 - iv. Brian Johnson We should agendize this for the first meeting of the fall term and discuss how to address it with our committees then.
 - v. Nick Sinigaglia Is there a reason why we would want to hold new courses with unfunded hours and not modifications?



- 1. Kelly Douglass If the lab eventually has to be removed, faculty may just want to consider if that's how they want to offer the course for only one year.
