FY 2017-18 Institutional Effectiveness Goals for Fiscal Viability and Programmatic Compliance with State and Federal Guidelines – A. Brown

- Bader/Campo moved to recommend that the Board of Trustees approve adoption of the minimum 5.0 percent unrestricted general fund balance target as described in Board Policy 6200 as the fiscal viability goal for FY 2017-2018 and the subsequent six years under the Institutional Effectiveness Initiative. Motion carried. (17 ayes)
- Bader/Campo moved to recommend that the Board of Trustees approve adoption of “unmodified” or “unqualified” opinions with no material weaknesses or significant deficiencies as the goals for financial reporting and compliance with state/federal program guidelines for FY 2017-2018 and the subsequent six years under the Institutional Effectiveness Initiative. Motion carried. (17 ayes)
