
- To better understand the withdrawals (W, EW and MW grades) for this semester, a data query* was performed for all instructional days for the 2018, 2019 and 2020 spring semesters.
- Comparison of withdrawals using "Days into semester".
 - Day-to-day calendar comparison yields results that are less comparable; different term start dates.
- Spring 2020 had completed 91 calendar days (as of May 18th)
 - results are presented in week-long (7 calendar day) intervals

- For reference, this is how the days are collected into weeks for the 2020 spring term.
 - The transition to online courses came at the end of week 5 / start of week 6.



 - The second graphic shows the same data, substituting <u>a running</u> weekly total to illustrate the cumulative effect of the W grades.


RCCD-Total W, EW and MW by week, Spring Terms 2018, 2019, and 2020









MVC-Cumulative Total W, EW and MW by week, Spring Terms 2018, 2019, and 2020


MVC-Cumulative Total W, EW and MW, weeks 3-13 MAT discipline only, Spring Terms, 2018, 2019 & 2020




NC-Total W, EW and MW, weeks 3-13, MAT discipline only, Spring Terms 2018, 2019, & 2020











RCCD-Cumulative Total W, EW and MW, weeks 3-13 COM discipline only, Spring Terms, 2018, 2019 & 2020







RCCD-Total W, EW and MW, weeks 3-13, Non-Transferable Courses only, Spring Terms 2018, 2019, & 2020















RCCD-Cumulative Total W, EW and MW, weeks 3-13, CTE Courses only, Spring Terms 2018, 2019, & 2020






RCCD-Total W, EW and MW, weeks 3-13, GP MAT Courses only, Spring Terms 2018, 2019, & 2020







• Spring 2018 and 2019 were very similar in terms of W grades, but this trend is different for spring 2020.

- In the earlier weeks of spring 2020 (through week 5), the counts of W grades were lower than previous terms
 - perhaps owing to improved counseling and clearer pathways for students
- The earlier (and lower) counts of 2020 W grades offset the cumulative totals, so that any increase in W grades due to the changes instructional mode may have been mitigated.

Future research activities:

Complete the analysis for the current spring term.

Conduct an analysis of withdrawals based on course attributes.

Merge with student demographic files to examine equity issues.
