However, lower division units may be allowed, if approved in advance by the College Professional Growth and Sabbatical Leave Committee, as part of the faculty member's planned professional development program. The courses must be directly related to the applicant's faculty service area (s), or the courses must be a series which would enhance and further the faculty member's ability to perform in his/her planned area of expertise. The planned lower division program must be completed before the units will be recommended for salary reclassification.
