Charge: The Facilities Naming Sub-Committee assists the chancellor in evaluating and making recommendations on naming facilities, events and programs in compliance with Board Policy No. 4400 (Naming of Facilities, Events and Programs). Facilities, events, and programs may be named for a unique, extraordinary, or significant personal contributions of someone closely associated with the District or a significant financial gift made through the RCCD Foundation. In addition to facilities, plaques, memorials, and monuments, selected events—such as athletics, fine arts, and lectures—other activities and programs are eligible for naming under this policy. All proposed names for facilities, events, and programs shall be consistent with the principles and mission of the District and must receive prior approval by the RCCD Board of Trustees.

CALL TO ORDER

Member Goldware called the Facilities Naming committee (FNC) meeting called to order at 4:05pm.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM OCTOBER 9, 2025

Member Harris motioned to approve the October 9, 2025 minutes and member Galicia seconded (8 ayes).

BP/AP REVIEW AND COMMENTS

Member Goldware shared that the District Board policy 4400 BP and AP. The BP has minimal updates and the AP has edits and most of the changes are for clarification. Within the AP, signage was updated and tied back to facilities language. Member Harris inquired about the naming of the library moving and the old building was named after the Aery family. Member Goldware shared an example of a building that has a plaque instead of a building name from a previous name on an older building. Member Kaatz shared when a new building is established there is a location within the building that will give honor to a previously named building.

FACILITIES NAMING REQUEST - QUAD ROOM 240 IN HONOR OF DR. OLIVER THOMPSON

Member Kaatz shared this is an honorific naming and member Wortman shared that the naming of this room is tied to the classwork that honors Dr. Thompson. Motion to approve the naming of Quad Room 240 was made by member Kaatz and member Wortman seconded (8 ayes).

FACILITIES NAMING REQUEST - ERIC PERRY SCOREBOARD

Member Kaatz shared this was a gift from the Perry family and this covers the cost for the scoreboard (minus additional costs around \$2,000). Eric is doing this to support the new

dean of Kinesiology. Member Wortman inquired about additional costs outside of the equipment purchase and the need for electrical support. Member Kaatz elaborated that the gift will cover the bulk of the purchase and the Tigerbackers support group will be picking up the additional costs aside from the equipment purchase. Motion to approve the Eric Perry Scoreboard was made by member Kaatz and seconded by member Harris (8 ayes).

FACILITIES NAMING REQUEST - SAN MANUEL FOR NURSING LAB 252

The Foundation submitted a grant for the School of Nursing Labs equipment. Motion to approve the naming of the Nursing Lab 252 was made by member Kaatz and seconded by member Bell (8 ayes).

DISCUSSION

Members discussed the Facilities Naming forms need to be updated. The next meeting will be held in the spring. Member Bell inquired about new naming for buildings that are being reconstructed and involvement with the Foundation, Aery family and inclusion to stay connected to the college.
