# Re-determining Course Alignment

Before submitting an articulation renewal form ensure there are no changes to the secondary course outline, final exam and/or final project that was previously approved.

\*The renewal form will be sent to the secondary articulation partner as the form is updated annually.

If there are changes to the supporting documents, you will need to submit as a NEW Articulation request.
